In the May 2018, there were many abductions and men and women who were affected by assaults nationally. The issue was not discussed publicly by politicians until May 2019.

Parts of England and Scotland were affected by sound disturbances where people could be heard crying for help after an assault or hijacking. Men and women who had enjoyed an evening had been approached by an assailant who seemed friendly. They were stalked, assaulted and abducted sometimes suddenly or sometimes over a long time.

The Rise of Fascism

Fascism became the new rule. Insults were prevalent and acceptable and people who opposed were expected to tolerate it. No action was taken. Fascism was the new rule?

The Fall of Censorship

Censorship was the prevention of many offences to protect the population of the country. Censorship was reinforced ethical standards of law and for life. The standard of censorship became so low that the result was disturbing. As technology was used to upset and disturb the population, millions left the country as there was no resolution. Authorities refused to implement basic laws such as non-interference and personal rights. Interference with transmitters and signals affected the physical and emotional health of the majority. The result is now a country without a rule of law, no democracy and trivialises equality.
